## Dear Parent/s and Guardians,

#### **Attendance:**

If a child of compulsory school age is registered at a school it is essential that they attend their school regularly and maintain a pattern of good attendance throughout their school career. Excellent attendance at school is important to allow a child or young person to fulfil their potential. Last year the attendance at Frithville was an amazing 97% as the National average for primary schools was 96%.

Every single day a child is absent from school equates to a day of lost learning. Attendance percentages can be misleading, please the reverse for an example. For some parents, 90% may seem like an acceptable level of attendance, but the reality is that 90% attendance means that your child will miss half a school day each week or 19 days of school during the school year – that's nearly 4 school weeks.

# A scary thought...

If a child's attendance is 90% each year from reception through to Yr 11; that is 4 weeks x 12 years, which is 48 weeks missed – this is over a full year of the child's education!

Well done years 1, 3 and 4 who still have 100% attendance since the beginning of term. How long can they keep it at 100%?
