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Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back:

Welcome to the new school academic year at Frithville. We particularly welcome all our new children and their families and hope you will settle into school life quickly and happily. We start the new school year with our value of Tolerance – treating others how we would like to be treated ourselves.

It is going to be a very busy and exciting term, especially with our application to academise. We will keep you up to date with all updates via the newsletter, website and Twitter. We've started with a bang, lots of information, hence the envelope. Three key sections: The Confidential Pupil Data Form, General Data Protection Regulation Policy (GDPR) and Academy Status

Class 1:

Class 1 will be thinking about stories with familiar settings as part of our English work. Maths will focus on recognising numbers, writing numbers in words, ordering numbers and beginning to think about ways of representing them. Our geography work will include learning about our local area, including Tattershall Castle. In art, the children will be thinking about the work of Henri Rousseau. During this term, the children will also be learning about what life is like in a Jewish home.

Class 2:

This half-term, Class 2 will be learning various elements of grammar and punctuation, which they will use to write an adventure story and a piece of persuasive text. Maths will involve the study of place value, addition, subtraction and measure. In history, the children will be learning about the Mayan Civilisation and in geography, they will be learning about South America. Art will involve the study of a South American artist.

Please complete the form for each child that attends Frithville Primary School and return to school by Friday 14th September 2018. Although it looks a lot longer and more complex than normal, there are only two extra sections, the introduction and photo section. The rest I've enlarged and hopefully made more user friendly.

General Data Protection Regulation:

As you are probably very aware the data protection rules changed earlier this year. We are now required to send the GDPR information out to all parents at the beginning of each academic year and whenever a new child starts at the school. So apologies, a little more reading. You will notice that we have to have your permission to use photographs of your children in every conceivable format. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to ask.

Academy Status:

Things are moving along very quickly... The consultation period to become an academy for both Frithville and New York starts on Wednesday 12th September and will finish Monday 15th October. We aim to sign the agreement at the beginning of November, with a view to becoming an academy and a member of the Horncastle Education Trust on 1st December 2018.
