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Dear Parents and Carers:

Welcome back – Autumn 2... And what a term we have ahead!

Class 1:

This term in Class 1 will be learning about and using the features of recounts in their writing. The children will also be writing their own stories. In maths, we will be learning about measuring length, multiplication and division. We will also be practising our multiplication tables for 2,5 and 10. We will be focussing on answering questions by really looking at the text during guided reading sessions. Our science work on materials will continue and begin to tie in with our history work on Tattershall Castle. Mrs Parsons is hoping to organise a class trip to the castle later on in the term.

Class 2:

This half-term, Class 2 will be learning aspects of grammar and punctuation before applying them to longer pieces of writing relating to persuasion and discussion. History will involve learning about the ancient Maya people while geography will focus on South America. In Art and DT, the children will use the work of Frida Kahlo as an inspiration.

**Remembrance Day - How we remember :**

Remembrance is part of modern British life, culture and heritage. It becomes a particular feature of the public calendar each year when public, private, formal and informal Remembrance events take place throughout the UK. Remembrance Sunday, which falls on 11 November 2018, is a day for the nation to remember and honour those who have sacrificed themselves to secure and protect our freedom. Poppies and other items will be on sale in school from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> November, raising money for the Royal British Legion to distribute to those service/ex-service men and women and families in need. The School Council will be selling items at lunchtimes from 1.00pm to 1.15pm. Thank you for your support.

We are having a big push on punctuality at Frithville Primary School.
