The UK Safer Internet has created a brand new reporting portal. Many of us know how difficult and frustrating it can sometimes be if you need to report anything, but there is help available. The service has been designed to:

- Provide information on community standards
- Give advice on how to report problems
- Mediate where appropriate or explain why content hasn't been removed
- Provide assistance in removing harmful content from platforms.
