### E-safety:

#### Warning - YOLO App

Yet another anonymous question-asking app doing the rounds. These types of apps tend to come and go relatively quickly, however YOLO has reached number 1 in the US as it links in directly with Snapchat, so there's a fairly good chance it's going to be around for a while. Just be aware please.

*Why are anonymous question-asking apps potentially dangerous to younger children?*

Are these Apps really private? On some apps your child will not be able to see who is following them, and everything they post can be seen by everyone. Please explain this to your child. It is also critical that your child understands that their profile is public and searchable beyond app they are using. Their profile picture, background picture and posts are searchable on Google. Given this, it is critical that their profile name does not contain their first or last name, even though the app will automatically generate a user name with their real name upon account creation. If your child links their account to their Facebook account, friends will still be able to find their profile. Do you know the apps your children are using on their phones and other devices?
