This term:

Class 1...
During this term, Class One will be learning about what a poem is and creating our own as part of our English work on fantasy worlds. In Maths, we will be thinking about multiplying and dividing, measuring weight and learning about shape. Our history work will focus on a Victorian washday and how it is different from how we wash our clothes today. Our work in DT lessons will be around where food comes from and to learn about the basic principles of a healthy and varied diet.

Class 2...
This half-term Class 2 will be studying various elements of grammar and punctuation and applying them to longer writing pieces that will include an instructional text and an explanation text. In science, they will be looking at the subject of light, and the area of classification in plants and animals. History and geography will be merged as the children learn about the growth of the railway network with a focus on local railways.

At the moment it looks as if the Sports Day will go ahead on Monday 17th, however it will be a double playground session, due to the field being water-logged. If there is any change I will send a text on Sunday. Please could KS2 children come to school in their PE kits. Class 1 will get changed at school. Thank you.
