Class 2:

This half-term, Class 2 will be learning about various elements of grammar and punctuation and applying these to longer pieces of writing relating to adventure narratives and persuasive texts. History will focus on Ancient Greece while geography will involve learning about different aspects of Europe, including countries, capital cities, and physical and human characteristics. Within science, the children will be studying skeletons, muscles, teeth and food chains. Christianity will be studied in R.E and art will be focussed on patterns.


