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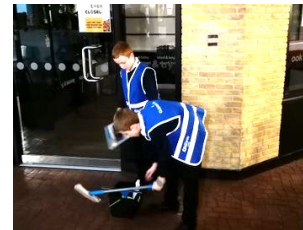

The issue isn't the app, it's the risks associated with children going live, who they are talking to and what they are doing.
